Holy Trinity Churchyard was established in 1854 when the newly build church was consecrated. Many of our Patrons, the Edbury family, are buried in several family graves. There are a number of Commonwealth War Graves and many other gravestones of interest.

Our community are proud of our Churchyard and Garden of Remembrance, which are maintained by a team of volunteers.

Please help us to look after the churchyard areas by observing the following guidelines:

- Do not place any plastic or manmade objects or ornaments on or near gravestones.
- Potted plants will be moved so that the lawn can be mowed. We cannot guarantee moving them back to their former position.
- · Take all rubbish away with you.

This churchyard policy of Holy Trinity Northwood is made under the Churchyard Regulations of the Diocese of London, and complies with all statutory and canonical requirements for burial grounds in England and Wales.
